This value is lower than the threshold of skin irritation probability (50%). Test items with permeability value lower than 50% threshold are considered to be at least irritating to skin

This product causes serious damage to bovine cornea. The calculated average IVIS is 56.92. According to OECD Guideline 437 (June 2020), substances with IVIS>55 can cause serious eve damage and should be classified as UN GHS Class I.
